

Notary Class: This course exceeds the State of California qualifications for new applicants and for notaries that are renewing their commissions. Commissioned notaries may take this course six months prior to their commission expiration date. Students completing the class will receive a State-approved Certificate of Completion required to take the State-proctored notary examination. The State of California will offer a same-day exam (additional cost). \$49 materials fee payable in class.

Advanced registration required. *No walk-in registrations.* Minimum age 18. Late arrivals will not be admitted and no refunds will be given.


Chartered Tax Professional for California Residents

The Special Enrollment Examination (SEE) is a test that individuals may take to become an Enrolled Agent in the United States. The credential is issued and regulated by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). By successfully completing the Federal and California lessons, students will be qualified to prepare individual tax returns for almost all U.S. and California taxpayers.

This comprehensive, self-paced course prepares students to pass the CompTIA Security-certification exam while gaining skills and credentials to enter the field of cybersecurity. Requirements include 15-25 hours a week to master material, including basics from computer hardware and networking, network security, and offensive and defensive security. More and more companies are turning to robotics as a means to increase production. Robots have an impressive range of applications, from "pick and place" for packaging, to welding, painting, or inspecting parts immediately after a process. Robots, however, necessitate effective preventive maintenance to ensure operation at full capacity requiring an experienced maintenance professional for troubleshooting and repair. The Robotics Technician course provides an intensive overview of the skills needed in the robotics industry, and students learn math, safety, quality, electrical systems, automation, mechanical systems, fluid systems, and rigging, all important to the position of Robot Technician.


* Student Parking:


