



PROFESIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Notary Classes

Instructor: Thomas Peavyhouse

Notary Public Licensing

Notary Class: This course exceeds the State of California qualifications for new applicants and for notaries that are renewing their commissions. *Commissioned notaries may take this course six months prior to their commission expiration date*. Students completing the class will receive a State-approved Certificate of Completion required to take the State-proctored notary examination. The State of California will offer a same-day exam (additional cost). \$49 materials fee payable in class.

Advanced registration required. No walk-in registrations. Minimum age 18. Late arrivals will not be admitted and no refunds will be given.

Notary Exam: Registration/exam begins at 4:00 pm, concludes at 6:00 pm. Exam requirements:

- 1. \$40 *check or money order only* payable to the Secretary of State (including renewals). *No Cash.*
- ID: Driver's License or State DMV card; Passport; Military ID; (non US citizens bring Alien Registration number).
- 3. Bring two sharpened, No. 2 pencils.
- Bring a 2"x2" passport photo to be submitted as part of the Secretary of State application background check. May be purchased in class for \$10.

They may work in industries as different as aeronautical engineering and healthcare or be self-employed. Korean Folk Art

Minhwa. the extraordinary and unconventional form of traditional Korean folk art, illustrates the common people's freedom of expression to reveal their innermost thoughts and dreams. This traditional Korean folk art of colorful painting was popular from the 17th to 19th centuries, until the end of the Joseon era. Many were painted by anonymous artists and shared among commoners to enrich the everyday lives of people in Korea. Free from formal contents, Minhwa expresses one's honest desire and good wishes for others in bright colors, humor, and hope. Using this art form, the common people of Korea were able to express their desires using various forms, from birds and flowers, to tigers and dragons, and also incorporated the ten longevity symbols. While evoking profound empathy and familiarity in the observer, it is an invaluable part of Korea's cultural heritage. Students must provide their own materials and bring them to the first class. 

Dropping A Course

Class dates are inclusive. Blackout days may apply. Refer to the website or your confirmation email for specifics.




